Rehabilitation Inpatient Program

Criteria for Admission

The Rehabilitation In-patient Program is located on 300 West, McLaren Site at the North Bay General Hospital. It consists of 10 designated Rehabilitation beds on a 20 bed unit servicing the district of Nipissing/Temiskaming.

The care team consists of:

Nursing
Occupational Therapy
Physician
Physiotherapy
Recreation Therapy
Social Work
Speech Language Pathology
Other services are accessed as required.

The type of patient referred for Rehabilitation on this unit will have a diagnosis of one of the following:

- Stroke
 - Amputation requiring prosthetic training
 - Post-op orthopedic conditions
 - Multiple trauma
 - Neurological illnesses
- (consideration will be given to other diagnosis that require intense rehabilitation services)

The patient must meet the following Criteria for Admission:

- 18 years of age and over (consideration will be given to younger populations)
- Medically stable
- Established diagnosis with identified co-morbidities
- Infectious disease issues identified and addressed prior to admission
- Pain control in place and will not limit ability to participate in therapy
- Functional deficits require interdisciplinary inpatient rehab team approach
- Demonstrated ability to:
 - actively participate in therapy (daily therapy, 2 sessions per day)
 - show functional improvement
 - learn and/or be able to follow instructions to support therapy goals
- Identified family member/friend to assist in discharge planning
- Discharge Planning initiated and documented
- Referring facility must be willing to accept return of patient to their facility once therapy goals have been attained or patient functional gains plateau or condition worsens.
